OSLC's "Little Hands; Loving Hearts" Child Development Center

What kinds of renovation are needed and where will they be located?

1. Plumbing- assisting a hired plumbing contractor with the installation of hand-washing sinks, counter-top sinks, and two tiny toilets.
2. Carpentry- installing a set of interior entry way doors, two Dutch doors in two classrooms, 2 windows in admin office, installing a storage shelf unit, and counters and cubbies.
3. Painting- applying a fresh coat of paint in classroom 107, 110, and a bathroom.
4. Flooring- installing a piece of vinyl in the Great Room for a dining area.
5. Cement- adding a sidewalk to the east entry of the building.

I don't have any construction experience or a lot of time, but I'd be willing to help when I could. Could you still use me?

Though we are in need of a few highly skilled individuals to help oversee that the work is done correctly, most of the folks we need just need to have a willing spirit to lend a hand when their schedule allows! A list of work call times and opportunities will soon be available!

How will these renovations change the look of our church home?

Nearly all the renovations will take place in the education wing portion of our church and will benefit our church in many ways.

* The added interior entry way to the east entrance will not only save on heat costs, but allow congregation accessibility should we decide to add additional parking on the east side of the building.

- The counters, cubbies, and sinks will allow much needed storage in classrooms for Sunday School, Confirmations, and VBS.
- Access to water for hand washing will also promote a healthier environment for all of our church activities.
- The vinyl flooring and additional counter and cupboard space will enhance our ability to serve funeral, wedding, or special events in the Great Room.

The only renovation taking place in the original part of the building is in classroom 106 which will include the addition of a counter/cupboard and a vinyl shelf unit to store paper products, large kitchen utensils, etc. There will be sufficient room to also store large church kitchen items that are rarely used, ie: popcorn and nacho machines.
